

# CODING UP

The city is getting feedback on the new Outside Storage Ordinance, Sec. 6.03.030 of the River Oaks Code of Ordinance, recently approved by the City Council, THE INTENT OF THIS ORDINANCE IS FOR ITEMS NOT TO BE PROHIBITED, RATHER, FOR ITEMS, IN PUBLIC VIEW, TO BE LIMITED. The best way to think of this violation would be “ACCUMULATION”; all property owners have useful items needed to keep up or enjoy property, such as lawnmowers, building materials, weed eaters, wheelbarrows, grills, fire pits, ect.

This Ordinance addresses the storage of these items. EXAMPLE: One grill stored outside of home that can be seen from public right of way will not be a violation, an ACCUMULATION of this item would be a violation. Accumulation being defined as “a mass or quantity of something that has gradually gathered or been acquired”. If own more than one item, there would need to be area where items would not be seen by the public.
